Scottish Futures Trust played a major role in shaping the conference and Scottish Government once again supported the conference and fielded a Minister for the pre-event dinner and the conference.

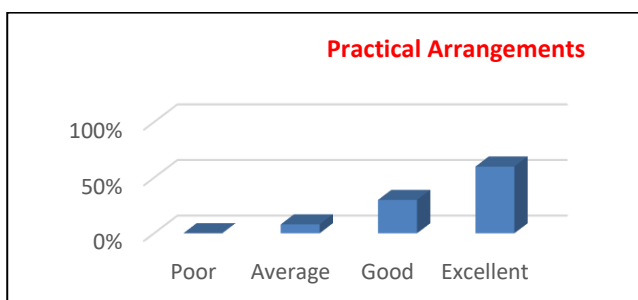
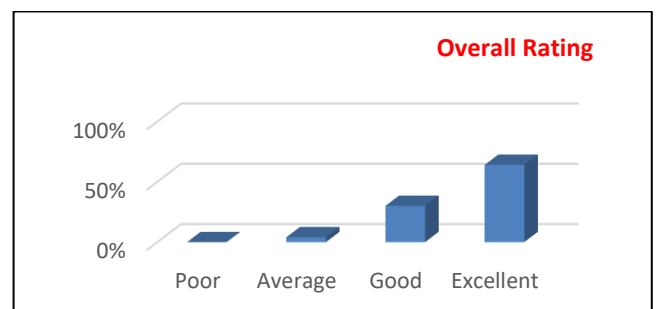
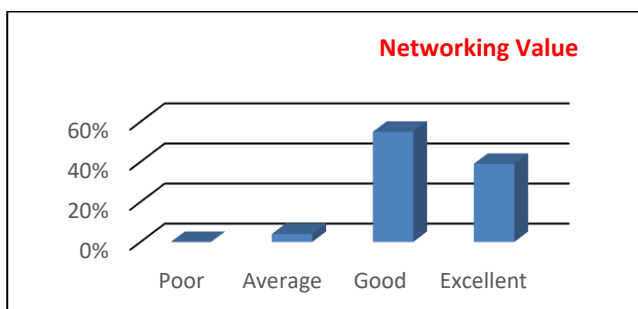
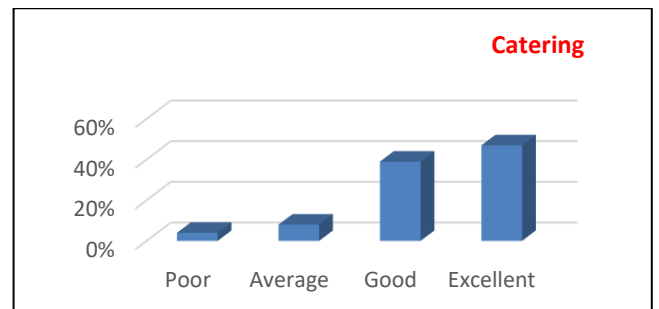
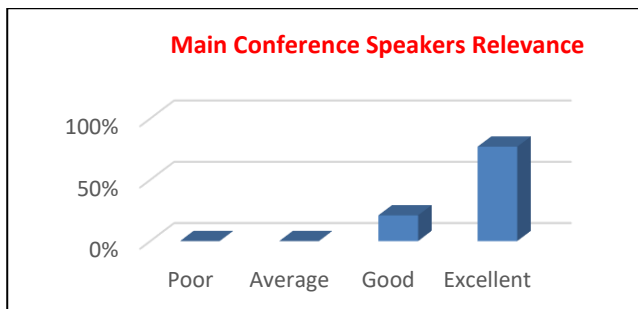
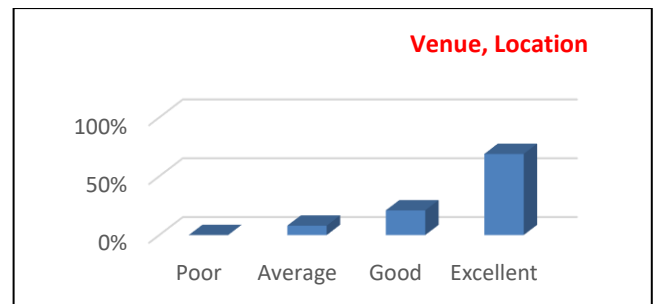
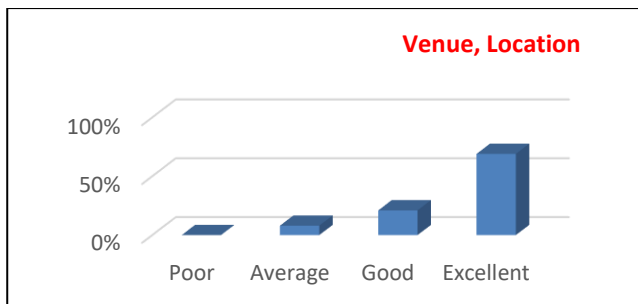
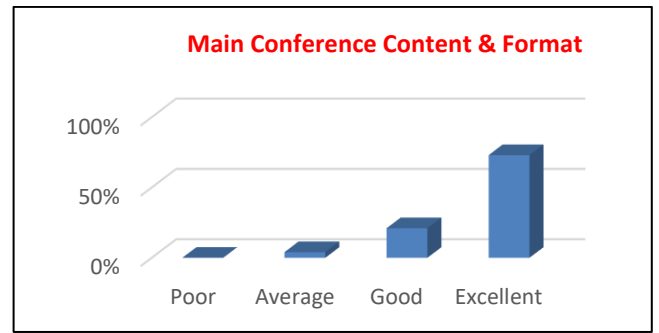
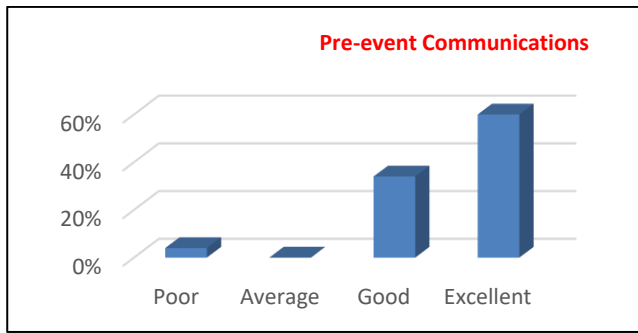

Results

The following provides an analysis of the feedback received via our web based survey. We had 25 respondents, representing a 'good sample' c. 13 % of the audience.

Commentaries and Observations

Overall the conference was very well received....

“This was a superb event, run completely professionally. The quality of the speakers and the information they imparted was fresh and of a very high calibre. Momentum is clearly building in the sector and the conference reflected that in a very positive manner”

But there were some key areas for improvement....

“Area for coffee and networking when we first arrived was a bit small and stuffy”

“Needed more local authorities in the room”

“I think next year would be improved by having a planning perspective on the panels to balance the views”

“Local Councils were under represented at the event”

In summary the conference was once again highly rated. We will take account of the feedback comments made in the planning of the BTR Forum Scotland 2019.

Our theme and content for next year will of course reflect the progress made over the next 12 months, we expect there will be a lot to discuss!

The vast majority of delegates [24 out of 25 surveyed], almost 100% of those that attended the conference rated it as Excellent / Good.
